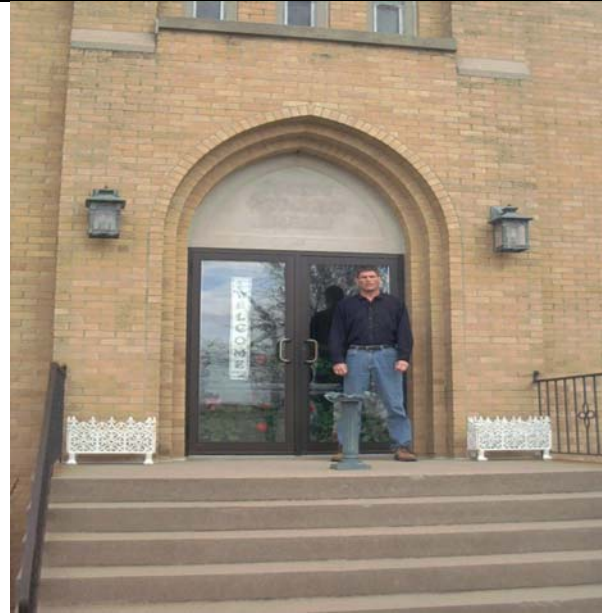
NO reminder telephone calls will be placed by our office.
